- Anti Social Behaviour (ASB)
- Fatal 4 (Speeding, Seatbelts, Drink/Drug Drive, Mobile Phone)
- Under Age Drinking

These priorities will be reviewed again in October 2022.

COMMUNITY UPDATE

During June we have continued to focus on our quarterly, local priorities.

ASB- Patrols of our 'hot spot' problem areas in both Louth town and rural areas have continued in order to address ASB and under age drinking. One UBWL has been handed out in Manby following an incident of a group of youths knocking on a victims door and running off.

Fatal 4- We continue in our quest to make the roads of Lincolnshire safer. As reported in last months newsletter, the new Roads Policing Unit (RPU) has now arrived in Louth and they are completing speed checks in and around Louth Town and rural areas.

Other news-

Male sentenced- A male has been sentenced with regards to 2 counts of indecent exposure which occurred in the Louth Town BUA. He has been sentenced to a 2 year community order, electronic/tag monitoring for a 6 month period and 5 years on the Sex Offenders Register. This result came about due to close partnership working between Louth NPT and the MOSOVO sex offender team at Louth.

Meeting - DC Holly Loyd had a meeting with regards to the setting up of a community alcohol partnership. Discussions are still ongoing with regards to implementing this in the Louth area. This forms part of our current Policing Priority of underage drinking in the Louth Town area.

Sgt Kelly Palmer and DC Holly Loyd attended a meeting in Marshchapel to meet with local residents to discuss the anti-social behaviour issues they are having in the area.

Engagement - DC Holly Loyd and PCSO Jo Drake recently visited the Greenwich Nursery on Highholme Road, where officers did a presentation on a day in the life of police officer. The children tried on police uniform and got to sit in a police car.

Louth Academy held a careers fair at the school recently and the Louth Neighbourhood Policing Team were in attendance.

Visit - DC Loyd and PCSO Drake along with ELDC ASB officer Chris Wesley and crime prevention officer Simone Wilson completed site visits at the Meridian Leisure Centre and London Road Pavillion in order to look at providing ELDC with further crime prevention advice regarding the sites and the Anti-social behaviour which is occurring in the area.

Enforcement - Louth NPT in partnership with Licensing, Environmental Health and Lincolnshire Fire and Rescue were heavily involved in the meetings (prior to the event) and subsequent policing of the LN event on the Llama field on Julian Bowers. Offences which have been identified from this event form part of an ongoing investigation.
